 08:30 HRS stop at View Point and start to explore wildlife on the road  
 08:45 HRS trekking from KM 33 for approx. 4 KM to explore variety of birds and gibbons  
 12:00 HRS back to Lala Mukha resort

**TOUR PROGRAM: FULL-DAY TOUR 08:00 Hrs – 18:00 Hrs**

08:00 HRS depart for Khao Yai for view point at KM 30  
**1<sup>st</sup> Trail:** At KM 33 for variety of Birds and Gibbons  
 Park Head Quarter (Visitor Center) next to Kong Kaew Waterfall  
 12:00 HRS lunch at Haew Suwat Waterfall  
 13:00 HRS **2<sup>nd</sup> Trail:** From Haew Suwat Waterfall to Pa Klung Mai Water Fall  
 View Point at Pa Deo-Die Cliffs (15 KM walk from parking lot)  
 Haew Narok Waterfall (1.5 KM), Khao Yai highest Waterfall  
 17:00 PM exploring the area where wild elephants occasionally come to forage or visit mineral deposits  
 18:00 PM return from Trekking Tour to depart to Lala Mukha resort
